7. Describe Jesus and the “Pitcher” analogy concerning you, others and love.
7. What promise does God make in Chpt. 1:8? What does it mean? What is ***our*** responsibility?...what is ***God’s***?
9. What does “calling” have to do with our live as a Christian? ... list several of the callings we share as His children...
10. Luther said our calling (vocation) renders us a “provisional life” in a fallen world. What does this mean for us a Christians?>
10. What makes a good spouse “helper suitable”?
11. Scripture talks about the kingdom of God in Lk. 17:20, Rom. 14:17; and I Cor. 4:20 ..What is the K of G and what does Matt. 6:33 have to do with it?
